2	2	Intro, Libby's background and credentials in the business Margaret's background Principals of grassroots, off the shelf, guts the same
3	3	Launched in 1999, now over 80 breeds using the system
4	4	From first principals the system has continued to grow and develop through its history, with all breeds benefiting from the ideas and enhancements made along the way
5	5	BGS Now data in for three types of sources all in paper format Outputs only certificate and Stud Book

8	8	That is all an enormous help to the breed sec, but the biggest benefit to the members is 'on line' View and search for information

### Pedeweb

10	Go to pedeweb	Log into BGS web site public access or member only
11	Animal search	Search for animals
12	animal	Click on animal for details
13	pedigree	Click on pedigree
14	sire	Anything in blue is a link, select sire or dam
15	progeny	Go to his/her record, look for siblings (progeny)
16	Show results	Look at show results
17	Point at owner	Link to owner and breeder anything in blue is a link
18	People search	In terms of people – data protection explained
19	person	If full permission given full details, even a link to their own web site
20	For sale	Animals for sale
21	Log into manage your own herd	Most exciting is the ability of the members to interact and make applications with the database. Remember they cannot change the database all applications still have to be processed in the society office
22	deaths	Keep the database up to date – log deaths
23	transfer	Notify transfers
24	Sale or hire	Identify animals available for sale or hire
25	Service certificates	Allow billy owners to log the services they have done Produce a service certificate to give to the nanny owner Update the society records so that the system

		knows the sire details are correct when the kid's birth is logged
26	births	Notify births Go through birth screen would help if all kids, including billy kids and dead kids were logged, to help with the show records

27	10	<p>Back in office, imported, processed and certificates issued in the normal way (3 generation pedigree certificates) NB the sec will still need to be very familiar with the rules of the BGS and know which registration category to put each goatling into, especially when both parents are not from the same section of the registry. (system will have logic to offer correct one but may be over ruled)</p> <p>Once processed the registered goats will be uploaded onto the database available for all to see and for you to list as available for sale, or enter in a show - we will come back to shows later</p>
28	11	<p>Everything we have discussed far are pretty much standard BRS and pedeweb tools. We will have to make some small changes to facilitate the multi-breed nature of your society. We can extract the data from your existing rather complex database and import it all into BRSoc. We could get the breed secretary up and running in a couple of weeks and he/she would then send out the passwords and data protection sheets for you to decide what contact info you want to appear about your herd, address, telephone, email and or web site, and to update the information held on your existing herd. It is likely for instance that lots of old goats will need to be flagged as dead or sold to get your own current herd records up to date.</p>
29	12	<p>The next stage of the presentation are proposal we have put to your committee to enhance the system especially for the BGS. Your current breed secretary does an enormous amount of work, mostly by hand, to keep the show results, milk records and the resulting stars, daggers, section marks and championships up to date and correctly published in the herd book.</p>
30	13	Milk Recording now
31	14	Milk recording with pedeweb (can still send by paper if need to)
32	15	In office – import, processing
33	16	Section marks

35	18	On pedeweb, we propose to also allow the members access to the milk records for any milk

		recorded female.

### Pedeweb

38	Pedeweb –show entry	Each show set up in office, with an opening and closing date Members can log in via the manage your own herd Alternatively show organisers would have a special password and could log paper entries, or those goats which have arrived fro an 'on the day' show.
39	show	Select a show
40	class	Select a class
41	list	Only registered animals in their registered ownership offered
42	add	Add to list

43	21	Closing date, entries down loaded and reports produced for the show secretary. In particular an excel spread sheet with all the details for all the animals entered. He/she can then add the milk records, and judges places
44	22	Spread sheet back to sec, sucked in, data held
45	23	Finally a formula would calculate which animals eligible for * and Q* And generation number And generation number for daughters
46	24	The judges report sheets contain the judges comments and the judges selection for best of show, best in each breed and reserves.  this information is cross checked manually against the milk points for the show, and the number of animals forward, to determine which animals actually win the championship and breed championships for that show. Currently this information is then carefully copied, by hand, onto a card index, one card for each goat that has ever won a championship or breed championship, with the date and the name of the judge.

47	25	Animals winning the required number of championships under the correct number of different judges are then extracted manually in order to add their Ch or BCh notation in the Herd Book.
48	26	To create a new screen in the office system for the breed secretary to key in the results An automated system to check the milk records, class size and allocate the championship Automated system to add the Ch and BCh Produce the certificate Add the animals to the correct Herd Book list
49	27	The only 'hitch' with this part of the proposal is that in order for the system to automatically check eligibility for Ch and BCh the information currently only held on the card index will need to be typed into the system. For all living goats This is not an insurmountable problem.
50	28	Cups and Special Award Each with different requirements – currently done by hand We would create a report, into excel, of all the show results, points awarded, championships and breed championships with the name of the show, the judge and the sire. This can then be used to sort and filter in order to identify the various cup winner.
